MEMORANDUM REGARDING THE MOTION DOCKET

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADVISED:

- 1. The regular motion docket of the Pike Circuit Court. Division I will not be openly read in court until the Supreme Court of Kentucky orders a resumption of normal business. The motion docket will, however, be published in a physical copy and available for viewing outside Judge Coleman's chambers. OR MT THE CLERK'S OFFICE.
- As is normally done, motions for default judgment; confirmations of sale; and approval
 of attorney's fees will continue to be granted or denied subject to the Court's review of
 the record for compliance with the Civil Rules.
- 3. Motions for injunctive relief/temporary restraining orders and other emergencies will be assigned for a hearing and in accordance with the Supreme Court of Kentucky's Order. With the exception of injunctions/TROs, it is within the Court's discretion to determine whether a matter is an emergency.
- 4. All other motions will be set for a hearing in mid- to late-summer. This is based on news reports, and other information released by governmental authorities, particularly from the Governor's Cffice and President Trump's news conference of March 16, 2020.
